2. Data We Collect

We may collect and process the following personal data:

- **Identity Data:** Name, date of birth, gender.
- Contact Data: Address, email, phone number.
- Transaction Data: Details of services purchased and payment information.
- **Technical Data:** IP address, browser type, operating system, and device information.
- Marketing and Communications Data: Preferences for receiving marketing materials.
- Emergency Contact Information: In case of an accident.
- **Children's Data:** Personal details of individuals under 16, collected with parent/guardian consent.

3. How We Collect Your Data

We collect personal data in the following ways:

- Direct interactions: When you register, book a session, or contact us.
- Automated technologies: When you visit our website (cookies, server logs, etc.).
- Third parties: Payment processors, booking systems, or event partners.
- Parent/guardian consent forms for individuals under 16 years old.

4. Purpose of Processing Your Data

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- To provide customer support.
- To process payments and refunds.
- To ensure safety and emergency response.
- To send marketing communications (with your consent).
- To comply with legal obligations.

• To safeguard and manage the participation of children under 16 with appropriate parental consent.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

We rely on the following legal bases to process your personal data:

- **Contractual necessity:** To fulfil our contract with you.
- **Legal obligation:** To comply with applicable laws and regulations.
- **Legitimate interests:** To improve our services and promote safety.
- **Consent:** When you opt-in to receive marketing communications or provide parental consent for children's data.

6. Data Sharing

We may share your personal data with:

- Service providers (e.g., payment processors, IT service providers).
- Legal or regulatory authorities if required by law.
- Emergency services in the event of an incident.
- Parents or guardians when managing children's data.

We do not sell or rent your personal data to third parties.

7. Data Retention

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Children's data is subject to additional safeguards and is securely deleted once no longer required.

8. Children's Data and Parental Consent

If a user is under 16 years old, we require verifiable parental or guardian consent before collecting and processing their personal data. Additional safeguards include:

- Secure storage and limited access to children's data.
- Regular review and deletion of data when no longer necessary.
- Clear communication with parents/guardians regarding data usage.

9. Your Rights
